I was not a happy camper. When I arrived at work the interim nurse manager was there. She asked me if the schedule change was okay. I told her it was not, due to the long hours worked the day before and being emotionally drained from covering for others when they called in sick. This was the first time a manager had ever heard me complain about work coverage.

Her demeanor softened. She said to me, "John I will cover for you this afternoon once my morning work is completed. I know the center has had a problem with sick calls." Embarrassed, I told her that she should not finish my afternoon as she had enough on her plate covering for two centers. I thanked her for listening to me vent. She said, "Let me see what I can do."

Within 5 minutes another nurse came to me. "John I will finish the afternoon for you. We all have tough days. Plan on going home once the morning cases are done." I was touched by her offer and thanked her for her generosity.

I was able to go home after six hours thanks to Christ's compassion reflected by my colleagues' actions.
